




Motor Box Bracket



Separate Carriages/Drill Templates

Separate the Bottom and top carriages and use the provided drill templates to mark the top and bottom carriages.






Rear Idle Bracket

screws.




Black Belt Bracket


Attach the Black belt bracket to top carriage using the provided screws, washers, and nuts.

Replace the top carriage onto the bottom carriage.







Motor Box and Bracket

Attach Motor Box Bracket to front of carriage using screws, washers, spacers, and nuts.

(Bag# not numbered)






Motor Box and Bracket


Black Belt

Attach the belt bracket to the carriage bracket with the winged crew and screw.

(Bag# 17)

Page 8 Black Belt

White Belt

To install the white belt, you will need to drill into the wood frame.

Slide the motor box as close to one end of frame as possible.

Mark where the eyebolt will be level with the Motor Box Pulley. (The eye-bolt attaches to the belt that runs through the pulley.)


2 Drill a hole, then install the eye-bolt.


Attach the white belt to the eye bolt using belt clamps.

Repeat steps 1-2 for remaining side of frame.

White Belt

Display

Insert SD card into display.

Attach display to display bracket with provided screws.





Install display onto the machine using the provided screws.

(Bag# 45)



Loosen faceplate screws and slide display bracket tab between faceplate and machine head. Tighten faceplate screws.






Page 10 Display

10 " DisplayMount the Display bracket onto the Tablet bracket using the provided screws.









Loosen faceplate screws and slide display bracket tab between faceplate and machine head.









Attach Motor Box Page 11

10" Display

Once the bracket is slid in between the face plate and the machine head, go ahead and put the original screws back in place, Make sure

the screws are in nice and tight.

Page 12 Attach Motor Box

Connect Handle Bar Wires

For Standard Model

Unplug the right rear handle bar (pictured at right). Plug the handle bar wire into the start/stop wire.

Repeat on remaining rear handle bar using the other end of the Y connector.

Note: If your machine only has one rear handle bar wire as pictured at right, you don't need to connect the needle up (remaining) connector.



(Bag# 7)

Plug the Y connector into the handle bar port of the black motor box.

Plug the display wire into the display and the other end into the remote port of the black motor box.



For Pro Model


Remove the front faceplate of your stitch regulator.

Loosen screw for start, ground, and needle up.

Connect the handle bar wire ground, start/ stop, and needle up into the "start," "gnd," and "needle up" of the faceplate.

With the wires connected, reattach the faceplate.



Plug the handlebar wire into the handle bar port of the black motor box.

Plug the display wire into the display and the other end into the remote port of the black motor box.



For Perfect Stitch

Plug the network cable into the Robotics Port of the Perfect Stitch Box.

Plug the remaining end into the Stitcher Box port on Butler.

Run Cables

Use a zip ties and anchor to hold cables in place on the top of the machine and the side of the carriage. (Do not tighten zip ties until all wires are in place.)


Page 16 Run Cables

Set Machine Type

If you have a Quilt-EZ Perfect Stitch Regulator, then set your machine type to Default.

7" Tablet:

Power on the display, go to **Home> Setup**





Go to the Advanced tab and set the machine type to Nolting.




10" Android Tablet:

Power on the display, go to **Settings** > **Advanced** tab.





Select Machine Type and set the machine type to Nolting.

Check Belt Tension

A correctly tensioned belt won't be as tight as a piano string but not sagging either. Aim for a taught belt.

Adjust belts as necessary.

Motor Pulley Cover (Optional)


Place cover onto two screws near the top motor box pulley.






Tighten nuts onto top of screws to secure the Pulley cover.


What is the Pulley Cover for?

The Motor Pulley cover is an extra safety precaution to protect your fingers from getting entangled in the belt.


We recommend it is installed after all your belts are installed and connected to the pulleys.

Appendix A - How to use Belt Clamps


A belt clamp consists of two clamps and two screws.




Using a Phillips screwdriver, insert each screw on opposite sides of the clamps and tighten halfway.




2 Thread the belt between the clamps, loop it around and reinsert it between the clamps.



Align the belt teeth, then finish tightening the clamps.



X Carriage Stretch Frame (Top View)



BACK LEFT INTENTIONALLY BLANK



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Step 1 - Cut out template at left.

Step 2 - position this page face up on carriage so that the top right corner is flush with the front right corner of the carriage.

Y Carriage (Top View)

Front corner of carriage

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Step 3 - Position Template cutout from Step 1 so that the top edge is flush with the guide line and the right edge is flush with the edge of this page.

OR

Measure 9 inches from the top edge 1/2 inch from right edge and mark hole. place template, and mark other hole. **GUIDE LINE**

Install Display

Line up display holder with handle bar brackets and install with provided screws.









Unlock clamp from back of display holder and raise clamp.







Page 2 Install Display

Position tablet in clamps, camera side up.

Lower clamps and tighten in place.










Lock clamps back in place and plug in wires to the DC IN and OTG ports.










Install Display Page 3

Plug the Ethernet end of the black cable into the display junction.





For Robotics Only:


Plug the ethernet end of the black cable into the Remote port on the Black Motor Box.





For Tin Lizzie Machines:

Plug the remaining end of the wire into the side port near the front of the Tin Lizzie machine.





For Upgraded Machines:

Adding robotics to a machine that was just upgraded:

Complete step 5 above.

(The cable should be located near the head of the machine where the display mounts.)



Page 4 Install Display

Adding robotics to a machine that has already been upgraded:

Remove the rear PCB box, and connect the remaining end into the indicated remote port.

(Route the cable internally if possible.)





Power on Tablet


Press the power button on the top right corner to power on the tablet.

Unlock The Screen


Press and hold on the lock icon, then drag your finger to the right lock icon and release.



Open an App

Press the apps button in the top right corner and select the app you would like to boot.

(Swipe your finger left and right on the screen to navigate to the desired app.)



Page 6 Unlock Screen

Close an App

While on the home screen, press the recent apps icon.

A list of currently running apps will appear.



Press and hold onto an app, then drag it to the right until it is no longer visible.


The app has now been closed.




Update the Tablet


Press the Settings

menu.






Press the 'System Info' button.

Troubleshooting

Symptom	Possible Problem	Solution
I'm losing communication with the USB	When the tablet is powered on/off several times in a row, it can cause communication issues.	Press and hold the power button on the side of the tablet. Shut down the tablet. Once completely shut down,
		restart the tablet.
